 - 2. Please note Hugh, Kathleen and I have full time employment so please allow us a week or so to respond. I suggest if you do no hear anything after 10 days please send us both another e-mail, to make sure the first one got through. We will always acknowledge your e-mail to let you know we have received it. So no acknowledgement, assume we have not received it.
