This is an announcement in regards to the Indianapolis Scottish Highland Games & Festival. After a long discussion and review by the SSI Board of Trustees and our current Games/Festival committee heads - it has been decided that the Indianapolis Scottish Highland Games & Festival will not take place again this year. This was a difficult decision to make but it was for the best for the society that we hold off another year for this event. The decision was based on a lack of a suitable or confirmed location, volunteers had diminished, committee managers are needed along with training that needs to be provided. At this time, we are looking at a smaller even for 2023. IMPORTANT: REQUIREMENTS FOR IN- PERSON MEETINGS

In-person meetings are taking place now. Determination of if or when we will have the in-person meetings will depend on the board's decision and we will be watching all updates in the media, statistics as a whole in making those decisions. The board has made some requirements and set regulations we will expect moving forward until we believe it will be safe to resume as normal.

- The board will need to see proof of your vaccination card when you come to the meetings (this can be the physical card or a photo of the card). We will be checking for them at the door before you enter. Signs advising this will be at the door before you are checked in.
- All members, guests and/or any attendee must wear a mask during the entire meeting - no exceptions unless you are eating or drinking.
- The meetings will be a "bring your own food/drink" situation. No food or drink is to be shared, unless you feel comfortable sharing with the people you sit with at the table. That will be at your discretion. There will be no buffet style eating at any of the meetings until further notice.
- There will be hand sanitizer and masks for sale if needed. They will be provided at the tables and at the welcome table.
- If you as an individual are under the weather of any sort or are feeling/currently sick - we are requesting that you do not attend the meeting. Please stay at home and get better.

Note: As of January 2022, the Board of Trustees have unanimously voted and have confirmed that we will not be allowing any type of exemptions (medical or religious). Vaccination cards must be presented or we will ask you to leave and not attend the

meeting.

If you are not able to abide by these new updates or requests, please be aware the board may deny you entry to the meetings. Our main priority is making sure everyone who attends the meetings/events are healthy and safe moving forward. Progress is being made but it is not the time to bring guards down. If you have any additional suggestions, please reach out to the board and let us know. Again, in-person meetings are important to continue with our organization but we want to be smart about how to proceed at this time. Thank you.
