Cousin Spotlight on Everett Utley's Family

Everett Vivion Utley was the first child born to **John** and **Edrie Utley**. **Everett** was born on January 19, 1925 in Lavinia, Carroll County, TN. He married **Lyda Sue McLemore** on May 6, 1951, in Spring Creek, Madison County, TN. They had two children: **Alan Thomas Utley**, born August 15, 1957, died January 9, 1988; and **Mark Anthony Utley**, born November 23, 1958. **Everett** died on December 18, 2000 and is buried in Highland Memorial Gardens, Jackson, TN.

A Mom's Viewpoint by Sue McLemore Utley

"**Everett** and I were married a little over six years when **Alan** was born. We had thought about adoption. Then fifteen months after **Alan's** birth, **Mark** was born.

The boys were very different in looks, interests and personalities. **Alan** always loved animals especially horses. **Mark** was interested in hunting and fishing.

At age 4 1/2 **Alan** developed diabetes. It didn't hinder many of his activities until adulthood. Then he had severe problem with his eyes, kidneys and heart. He was one of the first for Dr. David Meyer to use photocoagulation on the eyes. College was hard due to health problems but he finally earned a BS from UT Martin.

Mark never worried about school. He once said if he couldn't eat it or shoot it he wasn't interested. However, he did earn a BA and MBA from Union University.

Both boys worked in the summer when they were old enough to get paid. One summer **Mark** worked for the City of Jackson. He was about 15 and went to see Mr. Tobe Bailey who was a City Commissioner. He told him his mother was a teacher and he needed a job.


Both boys were active in church (choir, handbells, RA). They were very active in Scouts and earned the Eagle award."




