Spotlight on the Family of Robert Bruce Utley

Robert Bruce Utley was born on Sunday, November 23, 1913. He was the youngest child and sixth son of John Allen and Lilla Maude Jacobs Utley.

When **Bruce** was only 12 years old, his father died. **Bruce** and his mother, **Lilla Maude Utley**, lived with his oldest sister, **Annie Utley McLemore** for several years. The 1930 Madison County, TN, census shows **Maude** and **Bruce** living in **Annie's** household.

Bruce worked on the **Utley** farm until 1936, when he moved to Berwyn, Illinois. He married **Helen Marousek** on December 17, 1938.

They had two children, **Randall Bruce** ("Randy") and **Robert Bruce**, **Jr.** ("Bob").

Randy and his wife, **Kae**, reside in the Phoenix area. **Bob** passed away on November 11, 1992.

Brucie, as he was fondly called by his family, worked as a printing pressman until his retirement in 1975. In 1976 he and **Helen** moved to Phoenix, Arizona, to be closer to their sons and grandchildren.

Bruce passed away on December 21, 1996, after 58 years of marriage. His widow, **Helen Utley**, still resides in the Phoenix area.

In response to a questionnaire, Randy wrote:

My first paying job was working as a lifeguard during the summers in Cicero, Illinois.

My longest employment as an adult was as owner of American Teller Schools for 20 years with schools in Phoenix, Onesa and Tucson, Arizona.

I retired twice but for the last 3 years I have been the campus director at Apollo College. I manage a staff and faculty of 32 with a campus population of over 700 students. Apollo College offers courses of study in the fields of medical, dental, massage therapy, computer and veterinary assistant.

I am a graduate of Bradley Univer-

sity in Peoria, IL with a B.S. Degree in Business Administration in 1964.

Math was my favorite subject and chemistry was my least favorite.

I met my wife at Bradley University in 1962. We were college sweethearts. **Kae** was in a sorority (Pi Beta Phi) and I was in a fraternity (Lambda Chi Alpha).

We married on August 15, 1964. We honeymooned in Jamaica.

My children are: **Jeff Randall Utle**y, born July 7, 1967 in Elmhurst, IL; and **Heath Barrett Utley**, born February 8, 1970 in Elmhurst, IL.

My grandchildren's names are: **Noah**, age 6; **Brayden**, age 4; **Julia**, age 2 1/2; and **Kailia**, age 2. **Heath** and **Katherine** are expecting their fourth child any day now. [**Dane Matthew** was born on August 10, 2004.]

I served in the Air National Guard for 6 years.

If my home caught on fire and I could go back to retrieve one thing (assuming all people and pets were safely out) I would choose pictures of **Jeff, Heath, Kae** and **me** at **Jeff's** wedding.

If I could give advice on how to live a happy life, I would say always be patient and understanding. Be a good lis-

'My Dad, Bob Utley' by Shannon Utley

"I was your typical Daddy's Little Girl. My Dad was a very fun, practical joker type. He worked for Warner Bros. as a set builder. He built sets for movies and t.v. shows. I know he worked on "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" and I can remember visiting the set of the "Dukes of Hazard". He built all those cool jumps in the show! He worked there for many years before he started getting sick. He was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis in 1985 (I think). It

slowly started taking over his body literally from the feet up. He was permanently paralyzed and had to be in a wheelchair. Then, he had to have a tracheotomy in his throat to help him breathe. And without all the devastatingly sad details, he suffered for 19 years before his body gave up fighting. He was a very funny man. He was tall, over 6 foot. He had dark hair and brown eyes. He was born on December 30, 1945 in Illinois. He had several tattoos. I remember when I was 6,

he gave me my first tiny sip of beer. I miss him very much. I wish I could say more, but its too hard to do."
