

Fyvie:

Situated in the heart of the village is a large granite cross standing high on a granite plinth with dressed granite engraving on all four sides. The cross is decorated with a sword and a Celtic pattern and 'In Remembrance'. The memorial commemorates the dead of World War One, and it is inscribed 'Erected by parishioners of Fyvie to commemorate the bravery, devotion and sacrifice of the gallant men from the parish whose names and deeds will live for ever and who gave up their lives for king and country in the Great War 1914 – 1918'.
