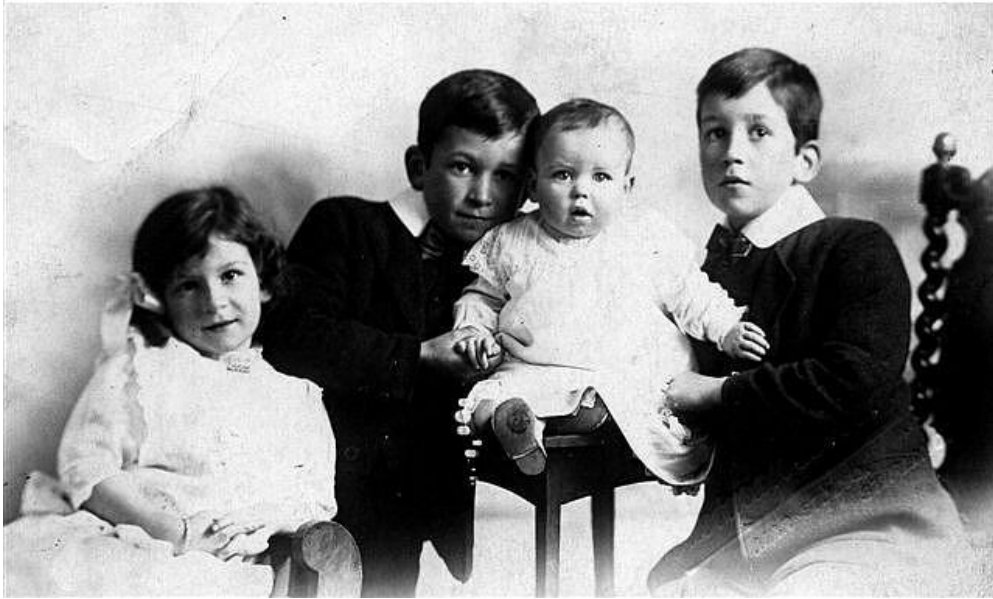

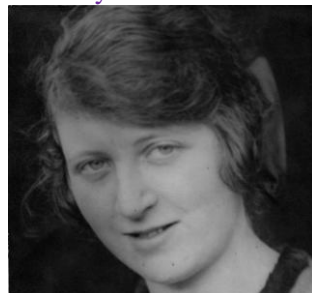

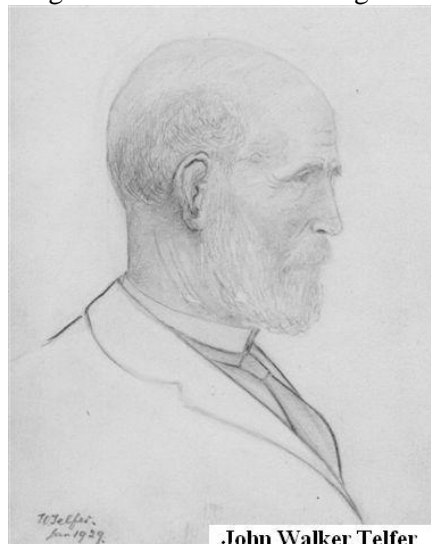


Her older brother **John** became an expert photographer and, with his mellow baritone voice, he made a fine Precentor in both the Baptist Church and The Church of Christ.
